Alcohol Policy

Alcohol in <u>College Hall</u> must be provided by Café Anna. <u>No outside alcohol is permitted in</u> <u>College Hall either in the form of BYOB or another caterer and no Café Anna alcohol is</u> <u>permitted to leave the building. If these Vermont State laws are broken VCFA could lose our</u> <u>liquor license.</u> Please keep this in mind at all times! We are subject to frequent inspections and need your cooperation with these rules and the law.

A few important facts to keep in mind as it relates to College Hall:

- Alcohol that was not purchased from Cafe Anna cannot reside or be transported through College Hall.
- We can no longer have private employee parties in College Hall unless someone is buying the alcohol from Cafe Anna and the alcohol must be served by a certified server. Anyone over 21 can get certified. The course can be taken online and the fee is \$25. Here is the link to get certified...http://liquorcontrol.vermont.gov/education.
- All doors to a function where alcohol is being served must remained unlocked.
- Other caterers can be used in College Hall for food, but not for serving alcohol.

Alcohol in <u>all other VCFA buildings</u> can be provided by outside caterers (including Café Anna which has a catering license) and must be served by certified servers. Students, faculty, and staff (of legal drinking age) can BYOB in residential buildings only and outdoors on campus, as long as the VCFA Alcohol policy is followed.

College Alcohol and Drug Policy

On the VCFA campus, consumption of alcoholic beverages and the use of drugs are governed by the laws of the State of Vermont. Furthermore, the following campus regulations are in effect for VCFA students, faculty, and other participants in VCFA-sponsored events, and infractions are subject to disciplinary action.

At official College and program functions where alcohol will be sold, only alcoholic beverages catered by an individual or business with a liquor license and contracted by VCFA or an individual program may be consumed. Public drunkenness and disruptive behavior in public places, including lounges, hallways, and stairwells is not permitted.

BYOB consumption of alcoholic beverages out-of-doors and in residential buildings on the VCFA campus is permitted on the condition that those involved conduct themselves in a discrete and responsible way. This policy applies to individuals and small groups only. Those wishing to organize parties involving the use of alcohol, indoors or outdoors, must contact the appropriate Program Director for permission and for information on caterers. <u>No Café Anna alcohol is</u> <u>permitted to leave the building in which it is served or sold.</u>
